

Homework Policy

Homework is a large part of the learning process. It is a completion, as well as a reinforcement of your child's day. We expect it to be done on a regular basis, just like their class work.

Homework will be assigned every night, including Fridays and holidays. Most nights, your child will receive no more than one hour's worth of homework. However, some nights there may be more, due to an exam or classwork that has not been completed.

Homework will be checked and reviewed every day. We ask that you sign the Homework planner daily and check to make sure your child has done his/her homework. You do not have to check for errors, but just to make sure that it has been completed.

If your child is absent, it is very important that they make up the missing work. Your child will be paired up with two buddies. Your child is **responsible** for calling up one of the buddies when they are out in order to get the missed assignments. Students who miss five homework assignments in a month will be **disqualified from one trip** from the year. If you have any further questions, please feel free to contact us at the school
